

5. What training facilities does FIERCE use?
 - Round Rock Sports Center (Indoor): 2400 Chisholm Trail Rd, Round Rock, TX 78681
 - McNeil High School: 5720 McNeil Dr, Austin, TX 78729
 - LISD Fields: Bible Stadium, Ranger Stadium, Rouse HS, Vista Ridge HS

6. How often do Academy teams train?
 - Academy teams train 2 times per week - one session is indoor, and the other session is outdoor.

7. Does FIERCE have goalkeeper training?
 - Currently, FIERCE offers once a week goalkeeper training sessions with high-level staff that serve as members of the Olympic Development Program (ODP).
 - In addition to weekly training, goalies at FIERCE receive a free keeper kit and seasonal glove stipend.

8. Can parents observe training?
 - Parents are encouraged to observe so they can meet other parents, players, and see the top level instruction FIERCE provides. We only request that parents stay off the pitch/floor and do not interrupt the training.

9. When does the season run?
 - FIERCE season: year-round training
 - CAYSA: September - November, February - April

10. When are Academy games?
 - Games fall on Saturdays and Sundays.
 - FIERCE schedules most matches on Saturday, but field availability and other factors may require play on Sunday. FIERCE respects player and family decisions on this matter.

11. How many tournaments do Academy teams play in?
 - Academy teams will compete in 2-3 tournaments throughout the year-long season.
 - Typically, tournaments will take place at the beginning of Fall, during winter, and after the Spring season concludes.

13. Does FIERCE offer scholarships?

14. How does the onboarding process work?

1. In order to try out with FIERCE, your player must [register in PlayMetrics](#).
2. If FIERCE is a good fit, an offer letter will be sent to your player through PlayMetrics.
3. To complete registration with the league, your player must also register in GotSport.
4. Upon completion of these items, our staff will begin the remainder of the onboarding process, including sending your player their personalized uniform order link.
5. From that point forward, all invoices and communication will come through PlayMetrics.

15. Are players allowed to play up in age groups?

- If our professional staff deems a player capable of handling the challenge, it is possible for them to play up an age group.

16. Are there volunteer hours required for families?

- FIERCE does not require volunteer hours for families, but we do have opportunities for parents to volunteer as Team Managers or supporting FIERCE events like the annual FIERCE Cup fundraiser.

17. What is futsal?

- Futsal is indoor soccer played on a hard surface in a small space without using walls. This type of soccer allows players to get many more touches on the ball in the same amount of training time and teaches them to increase their speed of play and situational awareness.

18. What if my child decides this is not for them?

- We work very hard to ensure that there is a good fit before a formal invitation to join the club goes out. However, if circumstances change we will release the player and stop charges (less certain non refundable expenses). This is just another way FIERCE is different.
